The SLUPB was established under the Sahtu Dene and Metis Comprehensive Land Claim Agreement (SDMCLCA) and the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act (MVRMA) to develop and implement a land use plan for the Sahtú Settlement Area, in the Northwest Territories.

## **Position Summary**

The **Land Use Planner** is responsible for the provision of comprehensive planning in the implementation of the Sahtú Land Use Plan (SLUP). He/she will support or lead planning and communication activities to assist the Board in meeting its mandate. This may include the organization of public workshops and events, review of applications for proposed land use activities, preparation or issue of papers, briefs, reports, and amendments to the SLUP.
