On behalf of the board I will make these comments in regard to your December 11<sup>th</sup> email.

- 1) In regard to the Tulita Conservation Initiative the board would like to propose to put it all under the SLUPB as conservation zones.

If Red Dog Mountain, Bear Rock, Smokes can have Cultural/ Historical significance to be protected.

The board would like to see the boundary changed around Willow Lake, Mahoney Lake Massacre Site.

If the boundary can be increased around Mahoney Lake to connect to the east side of Doctor Lake and to extend to above the boundary point (yellow).

In regards to Willow Lake and Kelly Lake the suggestion is to just have a buffer around willow Lake.

- 2) The board agree that Marten Lake be a conservation area which should be confirmed with Deline.

I hope this is the type of input you were hoping to receive and it sounds like a need to do community consultation again based on the changes.
