Dear Edna,

I met with members of the NWLC this afternoon in Norman Wells. We had a lot of difficulty at the meeting because of the scale of the maps in the Report. The NWLC needs a detailed map showing clearly the boundaries of the Town of Norman Wells, the Block Land Transfer and their relationship to the Zones. The issue is this - any lands in the Block Land Transfer that are not in the boundaries of the Town of Norman Wells must be zoned GUZ. This might already be the case but we could not determine this from the maps. This issue is related to the ongoing discussions for Self Government.

The second issue to come out of the meeting is technical in nature. There was a feeling that "values" as used in CR #14 should be defined as it is not clear what it means.

Members of the NWLC will continue to review the Plan and other issues may be forthcoming.
