To whom it may concern.

Thank you for the chance to respond to the Sahtu Land use plan. Santana Diamonds Inc. has been active in the Sahtu area since 2004 exploring for diamonds. We believe that during this time Santana has followed the law and made extra efforts to involve the communities in our activities.

The company has map permits, and mineral claims in the Sahtu. The current disposition of the mineral exploration rights held by Sanatana may be viewed at http://nwt-tno.inac-ainc.gc.ca/ism-sid/index_e.asp

Some of these mineral claims occur in special conservation areas, some occur in the Great Bear Lake Watershed others are outside these areas.

As we have expended millions of dollars of exploration work in these areas, using the current laws and arrangements and since we have been using community consultations and when needed sort and obtained land and water use permits, we would trust that as long as we continue this process, that we will be able to continue to operate.

It appears that the plan is not to allow development in the special conservation area, yet Sanatana has been granted mineral exploration rights in some of these areas, particular around Caribou point and the Lac de Bois and Colville Lake areas. If precedence is anything to go by, we trust our rights will be ""grand-fathered". If this is not the case we **[Buddy Doyle]** would hope to receive some sort of consideration for our then wasted efforts.
