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Dear Edna,

Further to my emailed report of September 30, 2010 I am writing to advise you that I met with the Board of Directors of Tulita District Land Corporation in Tulita on Monday October 18, 2010 and in Norman Wells on Wednesday October 20, 2010. The primary purpose of these meetings was to review each parcel that Tulita District Land Corporation holds title to pursuant to the Sahtu Dene and Metis Comprehensive Land Claim Agreement and how those parcels are zoned pursuant to Draft 3 of the SLUP.

Generally speaking lands owned by Tulita District Land Corporation were selected for economic development purposes. Generally speaking, Tulita District Land Corporation, is of the view that the current regulatory regime, in terms of issuing land use permits and water licences, works well in the Sahtu Settlement Area. Because of these reasons Tulita District Land Corporation is of the view that all of the lands owned by it should be zoned GUZ, with the following exceptions.

The following are the exceptions:

- Parcels 96, 97, 98, 103, 104, 109, 110, 111, 141, 142 and 143 should all be zoned SMZ;
- Parcel 99 should be zoned SMZ with no CZ;
- Parcel 100 - the only CZ should be around the massacre site at Mahoney Lake; the only SMZ should be around the shores of Brackett (Willow) Lake and the small lakes south of Brackett (Willow) Lake;
- Parcel 105 - the only CZ should be around the shores of 3 Day Lake;
- Parcel 112 - the only CZ should be around Bear Rock;
- Parcel 114 - the only CZ should be around the hot springs;
- Parcels 127 and 129 - the SMZ should be around the licks only;
- Parcel 131 - the only SMZ should be around Sheep Mountain;
- Parcel 133 - the only CZ should be around the lake;
- Parcel 134 - CZ should remain as proposed;
- Parcel 32 - the only SMZ should be around the lake;

In addition to the foregoing the Board of Directors also considered two other issues:

(1) The hearing scheduled for November 23 to 25, 2010 in Norman Wells should be postponed to June of 2011 to allow for further workshops and consultations;

(2) Any lands that are not included in the National Park or the NWA's, that are currently in the PCI's, once the National Park or the NWA's are established should be zoned SMZ.

Please add all of the foregoing to the public comments.
